TRANSFER – REGISTERED CATTLE

If you sell a registered bull or female to another registered breeder it is important that you fill out and file a transfer certificate with the Shorthorn Office, as soon as possible after the sale. Transfer fee is \$25 / animal up to 5 cattle, \$15 / animal for six to ten cattle and \$5 / animal from eleven upwards, this is paid for by the purchaser.

DNA – STUD SIREs

All sires used in your stud need to be DNA sire verified before any of their calves can be registered. It is one thing that members sometimes forget to do, so it may be a very good idea to DNA any sires used before they are joined with the cows. This way there are no nasty surprises if for some reason the DNA comes back saying that the sire does not match up. It is \$34.50 per animal for DNA profile and sire verification.

JULY

GROUP RUN CUT OFF – BY THE 10TH

ACTIVE DAM LIST (ADL) - JULY

The ADL comes out in July each year. It is a list of all the active female cows that the NZ Shorthorn Office believes are in your herd. It is very important that you check this list. Make sure that you cull off the list any females that you no longer have in your herd and return the form to the Shorthorn Office as your annual female fee is generated on the active breeding females in your herd.

AUGUST

GROUP RUN CUT OFF – BY THE 10TH

(July born cattle, 13 month aged cattle 400 day weight)

SEPTEMBER

GROUP RUN CUT OFF – BY THE 10TH

(August born cattle, 13 month aged cattle 400 day weight)

OCTOBER

GROUP RUN CUT OFF – BY THE 10TH

(September born cattle, 13 month aged cattle 400 day weight)

NOVEMBER

GROUP RUN CUT OFF – BY THE 10TH

(October born cattle, 13 month aged cattle 400 day weight)

FEMALE FEE & ANNUAL SUB – NOVEMBER

Each November the Association sends out an account to all members that include the Annual Sub which is \$150 for breeding members, Associate & Youth members \$30 and Overseas members \$100. If you are a breeding member the account will also include your female fee which is \$22 per breeding female based on your returned ADL.

JANUARY

GROUP RUN CUT OFF - BY THE 10TH

(July born cattle, 200 day weight)

Any performance data, for example the scanning and weighing of your cattle that you wish included in the months group run must be in to the PBB office by the 10th of each month. It is suggested that you do a 200, 400 & 600 day weight and that you also scan your cattle at either the 400 or 600 day weight for Fat, EMA and IMF. These are the suggested days for this data depending on date of birth which is included under each group run date.

CALVING RECORDS

By 31st March the year following calving

All breeders must submit an Annual Calf Return made up to the 31st December of any progeny that the breeders require to have registered and such returns to be submitted not later than the 31st March in each year.

APRIL

(September born cattle, 18 month age for 600 day weight)*

PROMOTION LEVY - APRIL

The Association has a promotion Levy of \$2 per breeding female you have in your herd according to the ADL list that is returned the previous year.

(October born cattle, 18 month age for 600 day weight)

GENETIC SALE - MAY & JUNE

Most Beef Shorthorn Genetic sales in New Zealand happen in May and June each year. It is a good idea to keep an eye on the website and Facebook page to see what sales are coming up. We encourage any breeders that have bulls or females for sale to list them on the sale page on the NZ Beef Shorthorn Website and include a picture of the bull / female if possible. Cost is \$3.50 per entry plus \$6 per picture added.
